

National Junior Honor Society (NJHS): The FMS chapter is selected from the student body based on five criteria: citizenship, service, leadership, scholarship and character. The chapter works on several community service projects.

The following are the criteria & process for selection into the National Junior Honor Society:

- Students must have a 3.8 GPA or higher on their 1st semester report card.
- Students must have scored Advanced on their previous year MAP score in at least one subject area.
- All students meeting the above academic requirement will have the opportunity to apply for membership in the FMS chapter of NJHS. Applications will generally be available in January in the main office at FMS.
- Students that apply will need to get 2 teacher recommendations.
- All of an applicants teachers will complete a short survey/questionnaire for student evaluation on a student's character. Teachers should include comments on the questionnaire/survey with evidence that reveals proof when a student scores below 3 points in any area.
- There will be a 5 member selection committee to review applications and make recommendations for admission to NJHS.
